Particular points to note:	<p><u>Integrated Report</u> – An in-depth review of the information presented in the report was held. The report provided an update on performance with particular focus on the following areas: risks, Information Governance, finance, QIPP, A&E, Referral to Treatment, Cancer, Improving Access to Psychological Therapies, Dementia, Transfer of Care for people with Learning Disabilities, and Quality. A number of comments and questions were noted and discussed. Consideration will be given on how information regarding primary care quality would be included into the report.</p> <p><u>Review of Risk Register</u> – The Committee reviewed the risk register, noting the recent changes including change in risk score for Member Engagement, new risk regarding delivery of the Continuing Health Care service, and closure of the risk relating to York Court.</p> <p>An audit of the Conflicts of Interest process for Joint Commissioning had been undertaken by Deloitte, with some important points of learning identified, which could be applied to delegated commissioning. These would be flagged up through IGC at the next meeting.</p> <p><u>Maternity Pilot</u> – The Committee was informed of a proposed pilot to contract for low risk midwifery care from small independent providers, with the potential for Wandsworth to participate. There could be a number of benefits and also some potential risks. Further work was being done around the quality processes and to consider in detail if this could be worth pursuing.</p>
